




The Jomon Prehistoric Sites in Northern Japan





The Jomon Prehistoric Sites in Northern Japan consist of 17 archaeological sites located in the southern part of Hokkaido Island and the northern part of the Honshu Island of the Japanese archipelago. This property is a valuable cultural heritage demonstrating the pre-agricultural way of life and complex spiritual culture of prehistoric people who lived based on hunting, fishing and gathering for a very long period of time, more than 10,000 years. 

A large scale stone circle characterized by flat stones aligned alternately in longitudinal and latitudinal directions, as if in a stone wall. The stone circle is as large as 55 m in diameter. Around the stone circle, pit graves have also been discovered, ritual artifacts such as triangular stone plates have been unearthed.

Archaeological Site Excavated Pieces of the Earliest Pottery in Japan

The oldest pottery in Japan was excavated at this site. The use of pottery, which is not suitable for a mobile lifestyle, is eloquent evidence of the beginning of sedentary life. Stone arrowheads have also been unearthed here, which suggest that people started to use bows and arrows.

A stone circle is located at the foot of Mt. Iwaki, and the sun sets on the summit of this mountain at the winter solstice. The size is 55 m in diameter. Disc-shaped stone objects used for the rituals and ceremonies have also been unearthed in and around the stone circle.

Goggle-Eyed Clay Figurine in Shako-Chan's Hometown

Famous for the discovery of goggle-eyed clay figurines. Numerous pit graves were built on the plateau. It is an archaeological site of a large cemetery site illustrating a high degree of spirituality. Varied burial goods have been unearthed from pit graves.



Valued for being one of the few shell mounds on the Sea of Japan side. Most of the excavated shells are from Japanese basket clams, but there are also dolphin and whale bones. Unfinished bracelets made of the shell of Glycymeris albolineata have been unearthed in great numbers. It is understood that shell bracelets were made here.





Earthwork burial circles were made by digging a circular pit in the ground and piling up the removed earth around the pit in a ring. Pit graves were placed on the inside of each burial circle. The largest one is about 75 meters in diameter and 5 meters in height.


